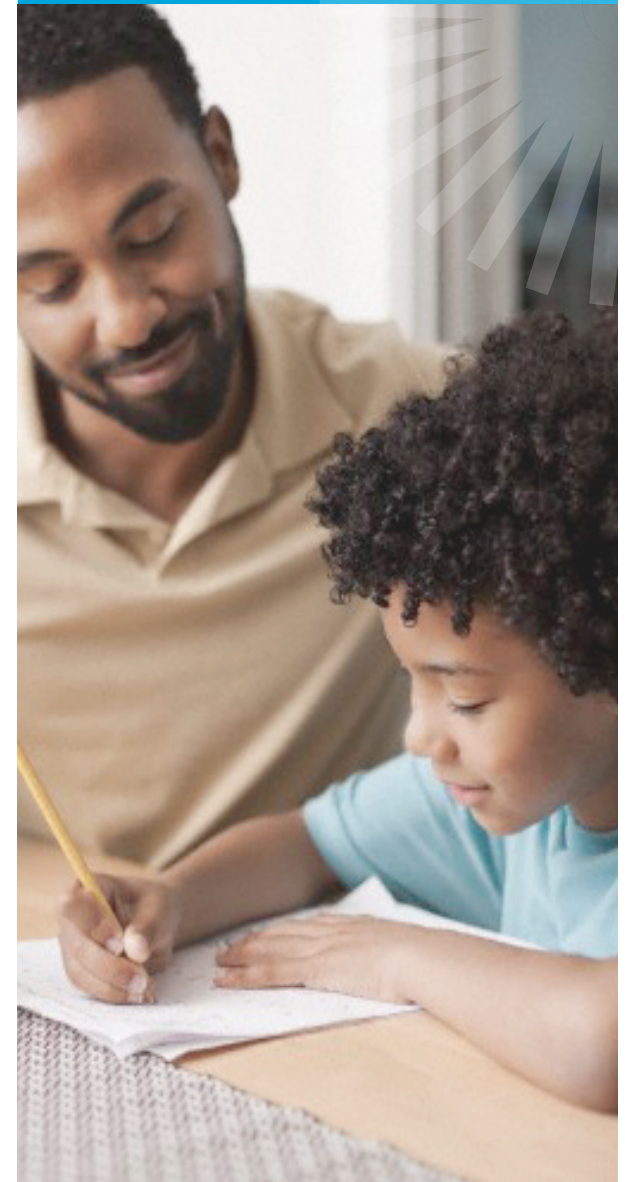

Families Together Building Solutions



Families Together Building Solutions (FTBS)

FTBS is an in-home program that works with families who are experiencing issues related to child and family well-being and are in need of supportive assistance.

What can you expect?

Families can expect a strength-based and solution-focused approach. The FTBS Worker will use the family's many strengths to assist them in solving the challenges they are facing. Service areas include:

- Parenting Support/Skills
- Assistance with budgeting
- Connection with community resources
- Communication and conflict resolution
- Building Positive Relationships
- Advocate for services that family desires
- Assistance with Counseling Referrals
- Assist family with household management



The FTBS program:

- Works with families in their own home
- Has staff available 24/7 if a crisis occurs with the family
- Will work with families during evenings or weekends when necessary
- Provides service to the family for ninety (90) days not to exceed a total of one hundred eighty (180) days of service
- Will average not less than three (3) hours of face-to-face contact per family, per week

Who can refer?

- Pathways to Potential Success Coach in Kalamazoo and Calhoun Counties

Who is eligible?

Family identified by a Pathways to Potential Success Coach that may benefit from the services offered through FTBS.
